

# Glacier Golf in Canada



The Banff area of Alberta is Canada's version of playing golf in the Australian and Swiss Alps, with the added bonus of glacier remnants. The Banff Springs Golf Course is routed along the glacial Bow River and includes the stunning architecture of the Fairmont Château. The Silvertip Resort in Canmore is just a short drive down the Trans-Canada Highway from Banff and offers some of the most breathtaking scenery in golf. Players will enjoy watching their drives soar down the mountain, seemingly floating in the air forever. Located a couple hours down the road, the Gray Wolf Golf Course features gorgeous panoramic views and the deadly "Cliffhanger" par three, on a course consistently ranked in the top 100 courses in the world outside the United States. And don't miss the incredible glacier views along the Icefields Parkway.
